



Central Solothurn

The «City of Ambassadors» is in central position in the heart-land or «Mittelland» of the country right by the motorway network between the large cities, especially the metropolises Bern and Basle: 100 km away from Zurich, 80 km away from Lucerne, 70 km away from Basle and 40 km away from Bern. Multi-storey car parks in close vicinity. Very well served by public transport and easily reached by train: 80 minutes from Kloten Airport, only two minutes walk to the railway station. Situated in Schänzlipark, the RAMADA Hotel Solothurn is the new top address on the river Aare.

Palais Besenval

Palais Besenval is located on the left head of the «Kreuzacker»-bridge and is a stately building dating back to the baroque period.
